

DOES EVERYONE DO IT? - ALL STUDENTS

-Four out of ten college freshmen don't drink.

-Most college students drink moderately or not at all. The percentage of students who do not drink alcohol rose significantly since 1993 - from 16.4 in 1993 to 19.3 in 2001.

-Everyone does not drink alcohol. During the past 30 days, nearly three out of every ten college students report they did not consume any alcohol, including beer, wine and liquor. Additionally, one-third of freshmen reported that they did not drink alcohol in the past 30 days.

DOES EVERYONE DO IT? - FIRST TIME

- 28 percent of freshmen say their close friends would strongly disapprove if they had one or two drinks nearly everyday.**
- 35 percent of freshmen say their close friends would strongly disapprove if they had 5 or more drinks in one sitting.**
- 56 percent of freshmen say their close friends would strongly disapprove if they had four or five drinks nearly every day.**
- One in four college freshmen believes other students' drinking messes up their physical living space, and 30 percent believe it interrupts their studying.**
